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# INTRODUCTION

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I first want to thank you for taking the time to read the part of the book that nobody really ever pays attention to it...the introduction. There are two reasons why this book is very important to me:

Reason Number 1: I did not grow up in a Christian home by any means, or what would even be considered a Christian home. We never really talked about God in my home, and yet there seemed to be an assumption that He existed. So to understand why the prophetic is so near and dear to my heart, you have to understand my journey to salvation.

Hindsight is 20/20 and I can now see how the Lord was drawing me closer to Him prior to salvation. My journey toward Christ began on a night when I was still living according to my criminal nature and I was threatening to murder someone. It was all too real to me and it was a still small voice that told me “this is not who you really are!”. That moment sparked a spiritual journey to discover myself and who I really am from a spiritual

perspective. This journey led me to look at Buddhism, philosophy, Wicca, and all sorts of other religions.

It was during this time that I begin writing a lot of poetry. Also one of my closest friends decided to cash in on an opportunity I offered them. I agreed to come to their church *one time....open minded*. You see, during my adolescence it would not be uncommon for me to be compared to the Antichrist (usually from non church goers) and so the idea of me going into a church was very far-fetched. God saw the opportunity and the openness in my heart and lunged right in. It was during this time that I prophesied my salvation through a poem I wrote called "A Gift" and it was in this poem that I would speak out Scriptures that I didn't even know during this time of my life.

The second reason this book is important to me is because it demonstrates the goodness of God. Let me explain further. When I was younger I was in special

reading classes, writing classes, and math classes, because I was below average in all those areas. This affected me throughout all of my school years and into my adult life where I felt inadequate to be writing.

A number of years ago I was given an opportunity to write my first published article for an online magazine and from there the rest is history. God gave me a voice to use well for speaking, but I never thought He would do much with my writing.

I want to encourage you, even if the content of this book means nothing to you, may these next few sentences bring great impact on your life:

Never despise the day of small beginnings. You never know what you will love trying, until you do it, even if it's not perfect *do it anyways*.

# UNMERITED ACCESS

*The Prophetic: A Reinforcer, not a Substitute*

**H**ave you ever felt like one of those Magic Eight Ball toys, or have you had someone tell you that they believe you have a word for them? While I understand and appreciate the desire to receive ministry, it leads me to believe we need a clearer and refined definition of the prophetic ministry in our churches. Bad ideas about what the prophetic is and what it is not have run rampant. Sadly, in many places, the prophetic ministry has become a substitute for individuals having their own conversation and relationship with God. The prophetic wasn't meant to be a substitute but instead a reinforcer of what you already have with God.

We've allowed ourselves to reduce the prophetic to a matter of desperately seeking out a word from another person while bypassing a direct relationship with God.

When you really think about that... it's an insult to Jesus on the cross. Why? Because He became the ultimate atonement and High Priest for us, that we would enter the Holy of Holies on our own. Otherwise, we make a mere person our mediator rather than Christ. This sort of truth needs to be the baseline for any book, teaching, or sermon on the prophetic ministry.

## THAT WHICH WAS LOST

You see, Jesus came to restore intimacy and communion with the Father. It says in the Word, "For the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost" (Matthew 18:11 emphasis added). Notice, it doesn't say that Jesus came to, "save those who are lost." It says *that which was lost*. So what was lost wasn't just people but a thing. What is that thing? Simply the ability to have *relationship* with God the Father.

Because this relationship was lost, man had to send a priestly representative into the holy place, strapped with pomegranates and bells. If those on the outside no longer heard the bells, it was assumed that the priest had sin in his life and he had been struck dead. The rituals and

cleansing process just to enter the holy place were lengthy and tedious. It wasn't for the everyday man or woman. In fact, it was for one man, once a year, under the perfect conditions. In other words, it wasn't easy to fight your way back to relationship with God on your own. God introduced His solution to this problem in the flesh 2,000 years ago.

On this side of the cross, we now enter that holy place covered by the blood of Jesus. We have the ability to go into the holy of holies but not only that, we receive the voice of God on a personal level. God set up a new positioning for us with this covenant. Hebrews gives us some clues on it:

“For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. Because finding fault with them, He says: ‘Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I

disregarded them, says the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them.'" (Hebrews 8:7-11)

God brought about this new concept to take man from having to rely on man for a relationship with God, to man relying on God Himself for a relationship with God. This doesn't mean that leadership in the church and prophetic oversight shouldn't exist... but it does mean that your main source of knowing God shouldn't come from a central figure outside of Jesus Christ. He is the primary and supreme connection with God.

Jesus said, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me” (John 14:6)

The gospel of John says in the first chapter, “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God” (John 1:12).

Over and over in Scripture we see confirmation after confirmation that we have the spirit of sonship when we believe in Christ. As a result, we have an authentic relationship with our Father in that place. We see this principle expanded in John 10:27, “My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.”

This gap between us and God has plagued humanity since almost the beginning of time. God has always been in a position of desiring relationship with His people. Of course, a serpent came in and tried to offer a different relationship. Adam and Eve chose an outside source when they already had a direct connection. Sound familiar?

Today the church is tempted with the same lie. Many want to chase after outside voices and alternative means when they already have unrestricted, personal access to the Father.

## ALLEGED WISDOM

There is no need to come up with alternative methods of knowing God when the Lord has already established how relationship with Him works and functions. Alternative methods and alleged wisdom from another voice is the birthplace of deception.

The serpent brought in an alleged form of wisdom that allowed them to have the knowledge of the tree of both good and evil. God commanded us not to be double-minded. What Satan presented that day was a double-minded approach to life. Double-mindedness has its roots in the garden, where mankind chose to know two schools of reasoning when they should have stuck to one.

Look at Israel for example. They were enslaved in Egypt for decades. After finally getting freedom, one of the first things they do is ask a man to stand in the gap between them and God. Instead of having direct connection, they wanted a person to obstruct the pathway between them and the Lord. As time went on they kept the same pattern and chose to have a King over them rather than having God over them.

In modern church culture, we've often duplicated these same patterns of old. God has empowered and strengthened us to hear His voice ourselves. Many people do not have faith, which is a necessity for their lives, because they don't hear the voice of the Lord themselves. Instead they solely seek after a word or message from another person which doesn't produce the same faith that hearing God yourself does.

See, according to the Word, faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of the God (Romans 10:17). Many don't allow themselves to hear the Word of God for themselves. They do have the bread, the written Word. However, Jesus said, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). The continually proceeding Word is the *rhema* Word of God that we also live by. Some of us feel like we have no life to offer others because we ourselves are not in connection with the very essence of life itself!

When feeling lifeless, low in faith, and dry — we've got to be willing to ask ourselves if we've substituted hearing God with hearing the word of man. Have we allowed a barricade to keep us from the direct access that God intended?

It's clear that new testament prophetic ministry was never intended to be a substitute for personal communion with God for ourselves. This might seem elementary but we have to look at the condition of the body as a whole and realize that the prophetic sect of Christianity very much depends on specific individuals for all direction, guidance, and counsel. Now, I do believe that there is wisdom in the multitude of counselors and that things are established in the mouth of two or three witnesses. Telling God that you'd like confirmation about something you think you heard from Him is perfectly fine. There is nothing wrong with that. It's safe to bounce things off of leaders and to seek after a more clear revelation. Yet does that steal from the reality that we need to be approaching Jesus for ourselves and by ourselves? Not at all!

The purpose of church infrastructure has never been about a person standing in the gap for another person to approach God. It's always been about the church creating a pathway and building blocks for the body to reach God on their own right. A pastor's role is not to hear God for you or to be the only one dispensing wisdom to you. A pastor's role is to confirm what God is already doing in

you and stir you up to continue approaching Jesus in the secret place.

The prophetic isn't the sole directive in our lives. It's a timely confirmation that validates what we've already been hearing in secret. If you just went from prophetic word to prophetic word, you'd be shaky and perhaps unstable. Here is an example from my own life: I recently received multiple prophetic words in just one day from two different people. Both words said the exact same thing.

One was from a substantial leader whom I trust hears the Lord and the other was from someone I have no relationship with and typically would not give weight to such a life altering word (yes, sometimes God does this to humble me in my thoughts). It certainly got my attention. The fact that they both uttered the same thing definitely is noteworthy... especially considering both words came within a 24 hour period. However, I still have to hear God

on my own. Faith comes by hearing... and hearing is an individual experience.

Even though I have the word of someone else, I still need the word myself from the Lord directly. We don't live, act, and react to words from others solely. A direct pursuit of the voice of the Lord is required on our part. Don't allow yourself to slip into ancient patterns of mediation with God through earthly people... no matter how venerated the person might be. Allow yourself to be bolstered and encouraged by them while still relentlessly pursuing the Voice Himself.

# CLEARING THE WATERS

*Solving Mysteries through Intimacy*

**P**eople often talk about how a prophetic word sounds like riddles and is a bit mystical and tough to understand. I believe this can be because there is a lack of intimacy with Jesus on their part. They aren't hearing God for themselves in private so when a prophetic word comes through a person of God, it's hard to make sense of what is being communicated. Intimacy is key for communication on every level.

If a husband and wife are having issues, it's often the result of a communication breakdown. They stop talking. As a result intimacy goes away and understanding one another becomes a challenge. It's no different with the voice of Jesus in our lives. Intimacy with Jesus clears

murky waters and allows us to more easily make out prophetic utterance we might receive.

I also want to say, it's not about merely hearing but listening. We can hear one another all day without ever listening. We could hear God through this minister and that minister but listening to Him for ourselves is another ball park.

We so often have allowed our understanding of the prophetic to replace intimacy. We have allowed plastic to replace that which is real and authentic. The Israelites had this downfall in Egypt. Because they didn't have a direct connection with God and used a middleman instead. They recreated the very thing God came to deliver them from. When we do this it creates a form of imprisonment in our souls.

The Israelites and many others in the Old Covenant who relied on earthly mediators often spoke of dark secrets and mysteries that surrounded God. God was shrouded in mystery to them. This is the direct result of having a second-hand connection with God. As a first hand, personal relationship takes place, the mystery is solved and the stuff that was murky becomes clear.

## THE OBEDIENCE KEY

There are many people with prophetic promises with absolutely no results. Why? I think that answer is somewhere between a lack of intimacy and obedience. When you hear the word of the Lord... how, when and why are not the issue. It's a matter of obedience. There is a constant and proven principle in Scripture that those who accomplished great things started with obedience.

Disobedience gets you put in the belly of a whale. In the belly of the whale, Jonah literally said, "My life is going through hell." Disobedience leaves you wandering in a wilderness for 40 years when it should have been a 40 day journey. Lack of intimacy and obedience delays the promise and leaves you empty handed.

So many believers say, "I'm going through hell. I'm in the wilderness." When often the answer is, "No! You're being disobedient." When was the last time you heard from the Lord for yourself? Often our battles are not some random, ominous attack from hell... they're simply the direct result of disobedience. We shouldn't hyper-spiritualize battles when the battle is simply the result of a lack of intimacy and plenty of disobedience.

Many people go around boasting about the mighty apostle or prophet that said such and such over their lives. I'm not concerned about that. I'm concerned about what God said. I was recently praying for an extended period of time seeking God for direction in specific areas of my life. I got absolutely no clarity at all. However, as I was headed to a vacation, the Lord began speaking to me. He said, "I want you to reshape your focus and prepare for influence in China and I want you to prepare yourself to go to China." I didn't understand it... yet through intimacy I soon would.

## A SIGN IN CHINA

Following such a unique word, I was still on vacation and seeking the Lord for more revelation. On this trip I kept seeing the same image: winds blowing from the coast of China into the major cities of China. I don't know much about China. I know of Beijing and Hong Kong... that's about it. Yet I kept seeing and hearing the Lord say,

“I’m releasing winds off the coast of China into major cities and I’m going to blow Fresh Winds through the body of Christ. As a sign, when you release this word, there will be an increased wind off of the coast of China.”

So I come back home and on a Wednesday night in church I released that word and declared that the Lord was going to blow through His body and as a sign of it, winds would increase off the coast of China. I figured the only way I’d be able to see if I was accurate or not was to check the weather in China. I teach students in our local ministry school that when you don’t know something, do something very profound: Google it. I did just that and I instantly was taken to a Chinese government site that tracks the weather. The weather for the coast of China was described like this:

"Increased winds out of the southern coastal region will go from a category 4 to a category 5 in the next 24 to 48 hours.”

They measure wind speeds by categories in China. We measure storms in such language but they simply measure winds and speeds by category. Category 4 is considered

moderate winds. Category 5, however, is described as “fresh winds” on their own government website.

It was a literal sign and fulfillment of fresh wind blowing in the body of Christ! The Lord didn't merely tell me to prepare for influence in China but confirmed it with a prophetic sign! I was *blown away...no pun intended*. As you can see, prophetic dependence on someone else wasn't my compass. It was a direct connection with Jesus... hearing His voice and watching Him confirm and reveal a mystery through intimacy.

In the Old Testament, saints would go to the prophet of their day to hear the word of the Lord. Yet now we have better access... direct access, in fact. When you receive Christ, the Holy Spirit begins to indwell you. There hasn't been a closer connection to God in the history of the world after the fall. Yet we deprive ourselves of this gift by bypassing God to get to the prophetic word of man.

The fruit of intimacy is so available in God. Think about intimacy in a marriage. A marriage wouldn't be much without it. What is the fruit of intimacy in a marriage? Children! The fruit of the marriage covenant is clearly visible. Often we don't see fruit in our Christian

walk because we aren't experiencing the intimacy with God that produces it.



# STRENGTH RECEIVED

## *The Power of an On-Time Word*

**T**here is a strength and enablement that comes from a prophetic word in the right time and the right season. However, if we develop an unhealthy familiarity with it, we lose that sense of awe and wonder. The prophetic is supposed to strengthen and produce drive in us. Here is a great example of this from Scripture:

“But he himself went a day’s journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree. And he prayed that he might die, and said, ‘It is enough! Now, Lord, take my life, for I am no better than my fathers!’

Then as he lay and slept under a broom tree, suddenly an angel touched him, and said to him, 'Arise and eat.' Then he looked, and there by his head was a cake baked on coals, and a jar of water. So he ate and drank, and lay down again. And the angel of the Lord came back the second time, and touched him, and said, 'Arise and eat, because the journey is too great for you.'

So he arose, and ate and drank; and he went in the strength of that food forty days and forty nights as far as Horeb, the mountain of God." (1 Kings 19:4-8)

The word of the Lord gives us strength. Elijah was given a word from the Lord... and not just a word but a cake. He was ministered to in more ways than one. God is interested in strengthening your spirit, soul and body. It was just what he needed in that season and in that moment.

The 1 Corinthians definition of the prophetic is to *encourage, build up, comfort and edify*. The prophetic isn't to tickle ears or give an odd revelation. It's to actually produce strength. It's as though you are growing a little

sapling tree. To strengthen the sapling and keep it steady you string it up and drive stakes into the ground to keep it strong during winds so that it will grow properly and in the right direction.

The prophetic is the string and stakes, so to speak. The prophetic strengthens and reinforces what God has already been working in your life.

Here is the reality, you have to be on the journey in order to be encouraged in what you're doing. You have to be doing something! An object in motion will stay in motion unless stopped by an outside force... but what if it's actually empowered by an outside force? That's our world! We will go faster and become stronger when we, in motion, receive empowerment by a force that is beyond us.

Elijah, in the story above, couldn't keep going. He was out of life. Yet God showed up and spoke to him and strengthened him. Do you realize that we can tap into the

voice of God on our own? We can access this grace. It's real and powerful. We need real relationship with Jesus and not a substitute. Fake orange juice doesn't taste like the real thing. There's a big difference between Tropicana and Sunny Delight. There's a big difference between chasing after insight from any person of God you can find and chasing after the living God in private.

# DEMYSTIFYING THE PROPHETIC

*“I speak with him face to face...”*

**P**rophetic ministry doesn't have to be a mystical and shrouded venture. No doubt Moses had a prophetic relationship with God. Having said that, I love how the Lord describes His relationship with Moses in Numbers:

“Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream. Not so with My servant Moses; He is faithful in all My house. I speak with him face to face, even plainly, and not in dark sayings; And he sees the form of the Lord. Why then were you not afraid to speak against My servant Moses?” (Numbers 12:6-9)

I love the prophetic. I give prophetic words all the time. I believe in it. Yet I believe that God wants to be friendly to His people one on one more than anything. God was highlighting that what He had through Moses was superior than the clouded mystery that other spiritual people had. Plain face-to-face communion is what the Lord is calling us into.

When I first was introduced into prophetic ministry, I barely understood how to hear God for me. I was quick and sharp to hear God for someone else. Yet I would struggle to hear the Lord for myself. This was because I hadn't established the intimacy and relationship with Him that I so needed.

Not only has that intimacy been established now, but I have more clarity than I do in any other setting because I know my Shepherd's voice! I've got to hear Him for me before I run around hearing Him for others.

## A CREATIVE SOUND

In Genesis, the sound that came from God actually created the Universe. He spoke things that were not as though they were. God's prophetic voice has the strength

to restore someone. It has an explosive and powerful nature that can break people free from bondage. In Luke 7 the prophetic word brings healing to the body, spirit and soul. In 1 Kings 18 you see that it literally creates faith.

Elijah said to Ahab, “I hear the sound of an abundance of rain.” In Acts 2 they heard the sound of a rushing mighty wind. It doesn’t even say that they *felt it* necessarily... yet they *heard it*. Do you know who heard the sound? *Those who had been with Jesus!* They could hear the prophetic sound, because they knew the voice of the Shepherd. Being with the Shepherd tunes us in to recognizing prophetic sounds from heaven.

To break it down in the most simplistic form: the prophetic is simply us being a mouthpiece for God. Yet God wants to speak to you for your sake. It’s not for His sake. Many of you have probably heard your parents say, “Do you think I’m telling you this for my benefit? Do you

think I just wanna hear myself talk?” See, God says what He says for *our sake*... not His.

He wants to empower you for your destiny. Empowered people empower people. Strengthened people strengthen others. People that know where they are going lead others to where they should be going. The reason so many are wandering around involved in weirdness in the church is because the blind are leading the blind. People are not hearing God for themselves, yet they're running around exchanging prophetic words. The problem is, there isn't any display of the words being given.

God wants to demystify the prophetic and make clear what is being spoken. When this happens words won't simply be tossed around like a baseball but clearly understood and manifested in our midst. It'll manifest because of believers that are acting on what was spoken.

A believer that what is already in motion will accelerate when encouraged. When we aren't in active pursuit of God we are like a pinball launched around the machine. Yet when a word comes and you're already going after God... it's like putting rocket fuel in a car. You take off!

# SUSTENANCE

*His voice is our food...*

**T**he Lord longs to restore the prophetic back in the church. Some people say, “Yeah but we are in a more prophetic hour than the church has ever been in before.” I would agree with that to an extent, however, there is a greater depth to be experienced.

In many cases, the prophetic has become a lot of inspired compliments rather than truly speaking on behalf of the heart of God. It’s also common for the prophetic to be reduced to reciting Scriptures. That is good and fine because it’s the Word of God, however, there is a greater depth and understanding to be had about the purpose and intent that God has for the prophetic.

In many cases, the prophetic has become a lot of inspired compliments rather than truly speaking on behalf of the heart of God.

“It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.’” (Matthew 4:4)

This line was dropped in a moment where Satan was tempting Jesus during a 40 day fast. If you’ve ever been hungry... or even hangry (so hungry you are angry!), you know it would be tempting to make food from a non-food item when you want it and have the creative power to do so. However, Jesus points to a greater substance... the voice of the Lord. He is describing a dietary benefit from the spoken Word of the Lord.

Some folks say, “I don’t believe in the prophetic or the gifts of the Spirit operating today.” I ask the question, “Do you believe God can speak to you? Do you believe God could inspire you with a word of encouragement for a friend?” The answer is almost always yes.

And that settles it... they’re prophetic! It doesn’t mean that they’re a prophet. But delivering a simple, inspired word of encouragement to a person who needs it is prophetic ministry!

“So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.” (Romans 10:7)

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” (Hebrews 11:1)

So faith is birthed in hearing the voice of God. With that in mind, faith itself is a literal substance. It's a weighty, tangible reality that is obtained through hearing God. Many want an increased faith yet we can clearly deduct from these passages that it comes by and through hearing the voice of the Lord. It won't always be an outer-worldly experience or encounter... it might just be a still small voice. Nevertheless, that still small voice is faith building and world changing.

When the Word of the Lord comes, it comes as a literal sustenance to our beings. When Elijah was weary and convinced that he was the only prophet in the land, God spoke to Him and sent His Word. His Word came like a cake, if you will. It was sweet and provided what He needed to continue on. The Word of God gives nutrients, endurance, and energy. The prophetic gives us a revitalized outlook.

The Word doesn't just make you warm and fuzzy... it is to literally strengthen and empower you. Some of you reading this need to get out of a slump. May the voice of Jesus get you out of it! May His voice end those cycles.

## DIVINE DESIRE TO SPEAK

Here's something to make clear: God wants to speak to you. He wants to make His voice available to you. Even if He is luring you into a wilderness, He wants to speak softly to you. No good father neglects speaking to his kids. God is a perfect Father who desires communication with you. If the voice of the Lord is our sustenance, it's worth noting that such sustenance is freely given by Him, and not withheld for someone more spiritual.

It doesn't matter where you are going or where you're at, He will speak. There are a lot of people who might give you lots of different words, yet you can't neglect running to the voice Himself. I tell people that there is one place in your home that's more prophetic than any other. The shower. Yes, the shower. Why? Because it's complete solitude! You're alone with no distractions. God is willing to find you and share with you in places of solitude and

quietness where it's just you and Him experiencing togetherness.

One of the greatest signs of being baptized in the Holy Spirit is not speaking in tongues, as many believe. It is actually living in the *spirit of adoption*, realizing that you are no longer an orphan. You have a Father that loves you, wants to take care of you and speak to you! The seal of Holy Spirit upon your life is understanding that you are a son or daughter! You aren't just wandering about the earth aimlessly. You aren't here to just get by, pay taxes, and die. You have a destiny and eternal purpose!

Many of us are living on moldy bread. What is moldy bread? Moldy bread is yesterday's revelation and yesterday's testimony. Many people are living on what they did for God 20 years ago. I don't care about what happened 20 years ago. I want to know what you're doing today. What are you hearing now? I drive the point home to my students repeatedly *the value of asking yourself what is in your hand today*. Don't bury your talent and refuse your God given purpose and high calling! It won't bear fruit.

It's not about what you did a decade ago or what God was saying to you during previous moves of the Spirit. It's about what He is saying to you right now, in this very

moment... as you read this book by a tattooed, bearded preacher. You can't be sustained by old word but only *now* words. Let His current voice produce strength and sustenance in you. Stay up-to-date and present with God and His plans for your life.

# THE PRACTICAL PROPHETIC

*Basic functions of prophecy...*

**T**he Scriptures don't say to earnestly desire to *be* a prophet. It says to desire to prophesy. What is prophecy? To edify, encourage, comfort, exhort and overall to simply be a blessing.

“...desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.” (1 Corinthians 14:1)

What if we read that verse, “desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may be a blessing.” See, if it isn't blessing someone, it might not be prophecy. Our hearts should leap at the chance to bless someone, not just leap at the chance to prophecy.

Interestingly enough the word desire here doesn't mean to desire like you desire tacos. It doesn't connote a simple want. It's much heavier than that. It means to literally lust after spiritual gifts. Lust is generally regarded in the negative, but take the negative power of that word and apply it to a positive response and description of our desire for spiritual gifts. Wow! It's a whole hearted longing for spiritual gifts. Yet even above a healthy lust for spiritual gifts in general is the specific desire for prophecy.

The prophetic gift is available to us, the body of Christ, that we might encourage one another. Paul said, "Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing." (1 Thessalonians 5:11) Notice, he makes an assumptive statement by saying, "just as you also are doing."

Yet even above a healthy lust for spiritual gifts in general is the specific desire for prophecy.

In sales, *an assumptive offer* is making an offer with the default assumption that the person is going to buy. Paul makes an assumption about their current state as

encouragers. Could we make the same assumption about the church today? Are we encouraging one another? Are we edifying and building up others? Or are we too busy trying to figure out who is missing the mark?

When we become prophetic, we carry a ministry that reinforces and strengthens growth in others. When we start to prophecy over our friends it's like putting a stake in the ground and tying a growing sapling to it. We encourage them to grow in the right direction and our words reinforce them, not allowing them to topple over or get uprooted.

Jesus so desires fruit in our lives. Fruit only shows up on the limbs of a tree that is planted and secure. You have the ability to be a major part of this equation through simple, practical prophetic encouragement.



# STRETCHED AND EMPOWERED

*Raising up a company of people with unlimited  
potential...*

I saw a photo recently of an awesome shirt design but the text said, “the unloved son.” I loved the design but would never wear a shirt with that message! Why? Because I am *the loved son*. As far as I am concerned I am the *most loved son*! Just kidding...*sort of*.

God has such a deep love for each and every one of us. We’ve got to see ourselves in that light. They say that people are afraid of failure... and I agree. But more people are afraid of discovering how truly powerful they are. We have a tendency to get set free by Jesus and then imprison ourselves. Why? Because we are afraid of the unlimited freedom, power and responsibility that comes with knowing Jesus.

We need to move forward in the freedom and empowerment that's available. We haven't yet reached a place where we need to pull the reigns back and slow down. Many people say, "Well you need to take it easy because some people might take this stuff too far." Listen, we haven't gotten far enough! Jesus said that we would do "greater" works. We could argue all day about whether that's quantity or quality, however, we haven't reached those greater works yet. It's time to keep pushing.

Look at the Apostle John, for example. He was on the Island of Patmos and has an encounter like no other. An angel shows up and John begins to worship it. He is corrected for that yet he is so confused by the glorious encounter he misplaced his worship. Listen, I haven't yet reached a place where I am confused by my encounters with the Lord. Most people aren't. It goes without saying, we don't need to worry about pulling back the reigns. We are safe to encounter God. We are safe to hear His voice again.

I love hearing stories of empowered people. There's a church in L.A. called E58 pastored by Shawn Bolz. In the early days of their church, young girls around the age of 15 heard from the Lord to go out into the Middle East and

rescue sex slaves that have been captured by armies in the Congo. They went out and began rescuing women and seeing them liberated from horrendous situations... at a very *very* young age! Nothing about that seems wise or logical. Yet these girls heard the voice of the Lord and acted accordingly. Faith comes by hearing and hearing the word of the Lord. Faith comes bringing a literal substance that causes us to do what might seem illogical or unwise yet it's just what God called on us for!

## STRETCHED

I was in Brazil in March 2017 and the Lord said to me, "I'm going to stretch you." I didn't quite know what that meant but I was willing to find out. I was standing on top of a semi that was turned into a stage. They asked me to pray for healing over many people and nothing was happening. I was losing my translator and it wasn't quite working out. The ministry leader grabbed the mic and said some things in Portuguese. Then he looked at me and said, "Operate in your gift. Prophecy healing."

So I said, "There is someone here that is blind in their right eye. It's been that way since birth and the Lord wants

to heal you.” Sure enough, a 7 year old boy came forth seeing with both eyes despite not having a functioning right eye since birth! The Lord stretched me and grew me that night, and He continues to do so. He wants to stretch us and call us out into new and radical places of experience with Him.

## THE SONS OF ISSACHAR 2.0

There was a specific group of prophetic people called the Tribe of Issachar. In Scripture, the Bible says that they understood the times and the seasons. (1 Chronicles 12:32) They were a group of prophetic people that heard from the Lord and knew specifically how to give direction to Israel. Their specialty was understanding the Word of God (Torah), science, and astronomy. They had an intimacy with God and knew and understood the signs in heaven. Actually, the word *seer* in Hebrew is translated to the word *stargazer*. The “Sons of Issachar” were a company of people who were prophets and seers. I truly believe that in this hour, God is raising up a sons of Issachar type of people in the body of Christ. He is raising up prophetic seers who will know and discern the times

and seasons. They will understand what needs to be done in the moment.

This group of people will not only decree and declare the prophetic voice of God but will understand intimacy and the written Word of God. It's so vital. You can't walk in the prophetic without having an understanding of the Bible itself. You've got to understand the *logos* (written word) in order to interpret the *rhema* (spoken word). We need to understand both the old and new testaments and the entirety of the plan of redemption laced throughout Scripture.

This company of people will discern the season that folks find themselves in and how to successfully get to the next season. They will bring a word of release to liberate those who find themselves captive to dry, winter seasons. They will not just operate in the *prophetic*, but they will operate in *wisdom*. It's not about merely reciting the live voice of God but having the wisdom to know how to do

so. This isn't a closed company, only available to some. There is an open invitation to be a part of this group of world changers.

## FATHERLY KINGS

*A new breed of prophetic people...*

**P**art of standing in the office of a prophet is to equip the saints for the work of ministry. Ephesians says, "...for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ..." (Ephesians 4:12). It's to equip the saints to indeed prophecy.

We are called to earnestly desire prophecy, as we read earlier. One of the reasons being that prophecy is the testimony of Jesus according to Revelation 19:10. You would think that the spirit of the evangelist is the testimony or revelation of Jesus. But actually, the spirit of prophecy is the revelation of Jesus! Prophecy reveals Jesus in the *now moment*. We have an opportunity to step into that.

The purpose of this book isn't mere entertainment or to give a revelation to applaud that. It's to impart ability to carry a prophetic heart to shake a generation. It's to equip you to reveal Jesus through prophecy. It's to display the heart with which we operate in prophetic calling.

## ANOINTED KINGS

God recently highlighted a passage to me as He began to share with me about the heart of the prophetic:

“It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, but the glory of kings is to search out a matter.” (Proverbs 25:2)

In meditating on this famous passage from the book of Proverbs I heard the Lord say, “Wes, why don't you try this on for size: It's the glory of God to promise a thing but it's the glory of kings to walk out the fulfillment of that promise.” From there the Lord began to share with me how He wants to anoint His voices in the earth. His prophets, His eyes and ears in the earth... He wants to anoint them as kings in this season.

He is empowering us as a prophetic people to walk out the prophetic promises in our generation. I asked the Lord why He specifically wanted to anoint us as kings in this hour. He began to share with me how a king is the representation of the Father in heaven, in the earth. A father figure in a family protects, provides, cares and defends. A king is an even greater expansion of that role. The Lord wants to expand our platforms, increase our scope of influence, and bring about promotion for His glory.

It's like this: when Jesus was out in the water, He spoke from the boat to the people on land. He did this so that His voice would travel further. I feel the Lord wants to increase the distance that our voices will travel. He is interested in increasing not only how far, but how wide our voices carry in this time.

He can't entrust just anyone with this ability. He is entrusting kings with it. Why? Because kings have the Father's heart. Kings look out for the concerns of the people. A king isn't in office to be served but to serve. He is invested in the prosperity of the people and not his own gain.

The Father said to Jesus, “This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” That declaration set Christ up to be a voice to the people and those in high places, carrying the heart of the Father. We cannot have influence in these arenas without carrying the heart of the Father. We cannot move into a kingly anointing unless we first have the Father’s heart.

You see, a spiritual father will have influence over a region or an area but a king has an even greater reach. A king can call out cities, governments and entire people groups. Nations harken to the voice of a king. A king can reach beyond that of a father. Yet the prerequisite to a kingly anointing is walking in the Father’s heart.

God wants to raise up people in this hour who have the authority of kingship. We will be made kings in the earth by submitting to the King of Kings. We aren’t wielding this dominion just for the sake of dominion. We do so with the heart of God inside of us.

Many people boast about their authority and dominion. Listen, if you have authority yet you don’t take care of the people around you... you aren’t a king. You’re a dictator.

Being launched into kingship isn't about having power. But rather it is about having loving influence for God's glory.

**I**f you have authority yet you don't take care of the people around you... you aren't a king. You're a dictator.

A king is someone that the people love. When people fear a good king, it's not because they are afraid the king will kill them. It is because they respect the king's authority and honor the fact that the king will fight for them, protect them, go to war for them, and serve them well. God wants to display the heart of the father inside the kings of the earth so that His platform will extend through us.

This is similar to me saying that *the Lord wants to anoint you with the Spirit of adoption*. How so? Because the Spirit of adoption convinces you of your sonship. Why is that relevant? Because the reality is, a good son eventually makes a great father. The father's heart is a key and crucial part of walking in kingly anointing.

## A Good Son Eventually Makes a Great Father.

God wants to give us greater jurisdiction. This will only come through kingly means. There is a grace in this season for increase. Some of you may already have large platforms and places of influence. This is wonderful, but know that God wants to increase your influence. Jesus prayed, “Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You” (John 17:1). Do you realize that God wants to glorify you? He wants to do this that He would be glorified also.

The Lord is willing to put a light on you and shine on you in a way that’s noticeably different than the people around you, so that He might receive glory through your spotlight and platform. This might be for a season or perhaps for the rest of your life. The whole purpose, and sole purpose, of all of this is to establish the Kingdom of God in the earth. This doesn’t come without the heart of the Father and the heart of a king.

Psalm 103 gives a great picture of the heart of the father:

“And forget not all of His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s. The Lord executes righteousness. And justice for all who are oppressed. He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel. The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy. He will not always strive with us, nor will He keep His anger forever. He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor punished us according to our iniquities” (Psalm 103:2-10).

What we see laid out is a loving, gracious heavenly Father who keeps His children’s welfare in mind without fail. This same heart has to be transplanted in us. See, this is the side of the kingly anointing and role that perhaps isn’t talked about enough. God is expanding our reach and the intent isn’t for us to have a “bigger name” or increased authority... it’s to see the love of the Father shed abroad in the earth.

These things won't necessarily come by a trance or wild encounter but through face to face relationship with the Father. As you do this, your love will begin to replicate God's love. A prophet's purpose isn't to judge and call down wrath but instead duplicates the Father's heart. A kingly prophetic believer is one who sees opportunity to care for those with less and fill roles as mothers and fathers to a generation. Otherwise, we will just be dictators — causing people the wrong kind of fear. It's with the revelatory understanding that comes with the prophetic that we begin to see these crucial matters of the heart.

# RIGHTEOUSNESS AND JUSTICE

*The foundation of life...*

“Clouds and darkness surround Him; righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.” (Psalm 97:2)

Clouds and darkness speak of the mysteries of the Kingdom. It is with wisdom and revelation that we tap into those mysteries and draw them out.

Notice, the Scripture continually brings out the words righteousness and justice. In the Kingdom, God is always about what is *right* and *just*. A king carrying God’s heart must be about the same thing. Righteousness and justice are our prophetic standard. Look at these words from the book of Isaiah:

“Behold, a king will reign in righteousness, and princes will rule with justice. A man will be as a hiding place

from the wind, and a cover from the tempest, as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. The eyes of those who see will not be dim, and the ears of those who hear will listen.” (Isaiah 32:1-3)

What’s the product of a king walking in righteousness and justice? No blockage in hearing and no dimness in sight. Things are fully illuminated and completely clear. As we are talking about this kingly anointing it is important to realize that we will cut our own feet out from under us if we think we are operating in a kingly prophetic anointing with righteousness and justice. A lack of these things will spoil our call in this season.

The foundation of the throne of God will become the very foundation that we will build upon. It all comes back to the heart. The heart of a king is that of a father. A father looks after his children, loves them, protects them, and feeds them. A father battles the bullies and looks under the bed for the boogie man. A father is concerned with the details of his children’s lives. This is the standard we are called to in the prophetic. Not merely throwing words out and abandoning those we prophesied over. But

actually caring for the *person* and not just the *prophecy* we give that person.

My hope is that we, as a company of people, will gladly step into the kingly anointing that God is pouring out in this hour. I long for us to walk in a steadfast refusal to substitute intimacy with prophecy, but instead to utilize the prophetic the way it was designed to be used. From that place, we'll function as kings and prophets to our generation in such a way that our tent stakes are expanded, our reach is increased, and God's glory covers the earth.



# FINAL THOUGHTS

*The foundation of life...*

I hope this book causes you to want to get closer to His voice. The voice of the One who is setting you free and drawing you closer. This is my whole heart in writing this book. That this book would draw people closer to God. God wants to speak to you *and is speaking to you even now.*

It was once asked of me who I most wanted to be like in the Bible and who I least wanted to be like in the Bible. I most wanted to be like John, the disciple whom Jesus loved, because he could rest in his knowledge of the love that the Lord had for him. When it came time to answer who I wanted to be least like, to me the answer was simple, Ezekiel.

I would not want to be that weird and have all those weird experiences! But as I got closer to the voice of God;

which led me to being closer to the heart of God; I became perfectly comfortable in being like Ezekiel with the heart of John the beloved!

*I knew that I was loved.*

May you know this as well, as you get closer to the voice.
